## Dossier Report

**Project : Natural Resource Management and Empowerment and Enhancement of Livelihood of 30 Rim Area villages of Pratapnagar and Jakhnidhar Block through integrated Development**

### Project at a glance:

The project “Natural Resource Management and Empowerment and Enhancement of Livelihood of 30 Rim Area villages of Pratapnagar and Jakhnidhar Block through integrated Development” was initiated to create sustainable livelihood for the villagers of the Rim area of Tehri Dam Reservoir under the THDCIL CSR-CD scheme.

### Objectives of this Project

**The major objectives of the project are to :**

- 1) To provide Skill development and vocational trainings i.e. Computer Course, Tailoring Course, ANM course, Carrier counseling and Hotel Management to Rim area’s youths.
- 2) To provide free health facilities to the remote villagers especially targeting poor and needy Households.
- 3) To promote income through Garlic, Chilly & vegetable production and non farming activities ie. Mushroom cultivation, Cocoon rearing.
- 4) Promotion of dry land horticulture i.e. Apple (Anna) and Mango (Dusheri and Amarpali) involving women groups.
- 5) Reduce Drudgery of women by introducing low cost technologies such as vermin compost pits, Azola cultivation and poly houses.
- 6) Convergence of Govt. Schemes.
- 7) Established Farmer field School and Seed banks cum support centers and collaboration with line departments, NGOs, farmer’s organizations and allied institutions to strengthen the farmer’s knowledge and awareness.

## **Progress of the project year - 2016-17**

### **1.A. 02 Computer Training Centers in Pratapnagar and Jakhnidhar Block**

#### **Objective:**

To upgrade entrepreneurship skill at their door step or generate employment opportunities for local poor rural youths.

#### **Progress:**

Initially, door to door survey was conducted and list of unskilled and unemployed rural youths prepared. After short listing and recommendation of Gram Pradhan total **101 youths** (72 BPL including the SC and 29 APL) were selected for 02 centers at Dharkot and Mandar, Jakhnidhar Block. For boys and girls six months short term computer course was started. Kanda, Paturi, Dharkot, Rindol, Kholra, Mandar, Dhung villages get benefit from this activity.

#### **Out put:**

1. Total **101 youth** enrolled out of **61 youth** (47 BPL including the SC and 14 APL) completed in 02 computer centers i.e. Dharkot and Mandar. (*Annexure attached - No. 01*)
2. In the second Batch (**June 17**) Total 40 trainees are currently under training at Dharkot Computer Centres (*Annexure- 2*)
3. Computer Centre of Mandar is now shifted to Kathuli village from the month of July.

**Out come :**

1. The trainees are well aware about the basics of computers, advance computer hardware and software.
2. Mostly about 80% BPL viollage youths including SC HH are selected for training.
3. It is recorded 11 trainees get the job as a trainer in the computer centre of New Tehri, Chamba and Ghansali. 02 in NGO and one of the employee is working with local MLA office.
5. 1440 man days (**employment**) has created beades two local staff was appointed as a trainer and watch man.

**1.B. 02 Tailoring – cum- - knitting and Handicraft Goods production training centre for the women folk in Pratapnagar and Jakhnidhar Block (Centre to be shifted to be after six months)**

**Objective -**

- To empower the poor women targeting economically weaker section for income generation and enhance the ability through trained them in a tailoring skill.

**Progress :-**

The beneficiaries of this programme belong to SC, BPL, Widows and other weaker sections. Total 53 women trained in tailoring and amberoid work. 17 women are in tailoring business and remaining women are using this skill for home purposes.

**Output :-**

Total **68** women enrolled in 02 Tailoring centers ie. Dharkot and Mandar out of them **53 women (23 women in Dharkot and 30 Women at Mandar tailoring Centre)** has successfully completed 06 months tailoring course (**Annexure No. 03**) and using their skill for generation of income. The centers are continuing in running process.

**Out come :-**

1. Most of trained women are women farmers are trained in tailoring now they are preparing Simple and fancy Shut, Frawak, Patikot, Blawoas and all women are using this skill for domestic purposes.
2. 80% BPL House Hold (including SC) are benefited under this program.
3. 30% of the trained women among beneficiaries have started their own business i.e. Dharkot village is one of the example.
4. Some of the women have earned approx. Rs. 4000/= to Rs.5000/= income through this business.
5. 1080 man days (employment) has created since two local staff was appointed as a trainer with one care taker.

### 1.C. Vocational Training in Hotel Management and Auxiliary Nurse and Midwives Training

#### 1.C.1 Complete residential Hotel Management Course (01 Year) considering 10 Youth

##### Objective :

To provide employment to 10 rural BPL (including SC) youths in the Rim area villages through skill and vocational training in Hotel management

##### Progress :

Total 10 BPL youths (some SC) from different villages from rim area villages completed one year course ( 90 days IHM training, 180 days hands on training and 90 days practical training in Hotel Management through Institute of Hotel Management, Dehradun. This course started from 07<sup>th</sup> June 2016 to 2017 (01 Year). (Annexure attached – No. 4)

##### Out Put :

1. Total 10 BPL unemployed youths become skilled in hotel management from rim area villages and completed successfully their one year Hotel Management course from Institute of Hotel Management, Dehradun and now all of them get employment in different three stars and four stars Hotels and earning Rs. 10,000/- to 12,000/-per month. From this income they are supporting their family members.

#### 1.C.2 Auxiliary Nurse and Midwives training (02 Year Course) considering 05 nos. students in

##### One batch

##### Objective:

- To provide skill training and employment to rural BPL (including SC) women in the Rim area villages through providing them **Auxiliary Nurse and Midwives (ANM)** course, they may get employment immediate after the course and can support their families.

##### Progress

Selection of the candidates was based on the merit of the both entrance examination held at Dehradun. Project team receives 18 applications from the local women and girls. All 18 candidates appeared in the entrance examination conducted by Shri Guru Ram Rai Institute of Medical & Health Sciences (SGRR), Dehradun on 26<sup>th</sup> July 2016 and on 27<sup>th</sup> July 2016 at

Combined (P.G.) Institute of Medical Sciences & Research (CIMSR), Dehradun. Only 07 Candidates (03 BPL (01 SC and 02 Gen.) and 4 APL) candidates qualify the entrance test and get admitted in CIMSR, Dehradun through counseling. (Annexure attached – No. 5)

**Methodology:**

- Maximum age for admission is 17 years and 35 years respectively.
- Minimum education; 10+2 class passed from Biology or English and its equivalent with aggregate of 50% mark and 5% relaxation for SC/ST candidates.
- Only female candidates can apply from rim area
- Candidates should be medically fit for the course.

**Out Put:**

Present time 07 women Candidates who are under the 02 years ANM Course at Combined (P.G.) Institute of Medical Sciences & Research (CIMSR), Dehradun and all of them has successfully completed 01 year Course and now they get admission in second year course for 2017 current year session.

## **1.D. Organization of health Camp in Pratapnagar and Jakhnidhar Block**

### **1.D.1 03 Health Camps in Different remote villages located at centre places in Pratapnagar and Jakhnidhar Block in District Tehri Garhwal**

#### **Objective :**

The primary objective of organizing Health checkup Camps in the rim area villages are to increase the reach of medical health facilities to the poor, old age, women and children, needy villagers who are living in the remote area and lacking of health facilities.

#### **Progress:**

##### **03 Health camps were successfully completed in Pratapnagar and Jakhnidhar Block, Tehri Garhwal.**

The increasing burden of diseases particular in rural areas threatens to overwhelm an already stretched health services. In Pratapnagar and Jakhnidhar blocks, Tehri Garhwal especially in rim area villages the factors underlying the major diseases is well documented. Considering this, SEWA - THDC and HNBGU mobilize an expert medical team Dr. Kohli (Kohli Hospital Rishikesh) for the medical camp. The main objective was to provide free medical support to needy villagers especially to women children and old age people.

#### **Out put :**

- 1) First health checkup & medicine camp was organized at Primary Health Centre (CHC), Pratapnagar Block, Tehri Garhwal jointly by SEWA-THDC and HNBGU mobilize local people to attend this camp on 30<sup>th</sup> June 2016 and 04 specialized Doctors provided community health service to the villagers from Banali Walla, Banali Palla, Kholgarh Walla, Kholgarh Palla, Kotga, Kanda and Majaf.
- 2) The second and third health checkup camp was organized together in the occasion of International Yoga Day at Primary School, Kathuli, Jakhnidhar Block, District Tehri Garhwal on 21<sup>st</sup> June 2017 under the supervision of Dr Kohli, Sr. Phisiciam of Kohli Hospital Rishikesh. Medical team including pharmacist and pathology Doctor also provide facilities for blood test to the villagers at their doorstep. **Sri Vijay Singh Panwar, MLA, Pratapnagar** participated in this Health Checkup camp as a "**Chief Guest**". Total **86 patients** were examine (Female – 69 & Male – 17) and provided proper instant treatment with free medicines. *Total 11 villages* benefited under this health camp were Kathuli, Badeel, Pachri, Siloli, Bhuniyara, Kholi, Khand, Gandoli, Kangsali, Jalwal Gaon and Rindol. Pharmists are distributed of Tonics and medicines to patients. **(Annexure Attached - 06)**

#### **Outcome :**

- It serves as great help to those who cannot afford expensive treatment and medicine. Medical Specialists examine local villagers at their doorstep. Total 86 patients get benefit.

## **1.E. Sustainable Livelihood activities including improvement in Agriculture and Horticulture Programme**

### **1.E.1 50 Agriculture plots promotion through production of Garlic (organic) and Chilli (Organic) production in a 01 year crop cycle with 50 small and marginal women farmers in Pratapnagar and Jakhnidahr - 50 Demo**

#### **Objective :**

1. Organic Agriculture should be promoted in order to get quality food and maintain soil productivity.
2. To promote women by way micro finance for improving livelihood of poor women.

#### **Progress :-**

1. HNBSGU Project team distributed 600 kgs. Garlic Seed ( Variety R.S. Sanker – 36) to 57 ( 39 BPL included SC and 18 APL) potential women Farmers in 12 villages (i.e. Khand, Siloli, Kotchuri, Paturi, Dharkot, Bangdwara, Kholi, Kathuli, Rauniya, Kangsali, Pandar Gaon and Kudiya Gaon), Pratapnagar and Jakhnidhar Blocks, Tehri District on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2016.
2. For the soil treatment and to control pest attack total 01 Qtl. 15 Kgs. Neem Khali (Per farmer 02 Kgs.) was distributed to the farmers. After expert advice from the Horticulture Department and Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK) Scientists Total 03 kgs. Trico drama (per farmer 0.05 Gram) distributed to farmers for before sowing Seeds in the fields.  
(Beneficiaries list and production list - Annexure attached – No. 7)

#### **Output :**

1. Provide Field Training by University experts to 57 women farmers among 40 were BPL HH.
2. 60 Nalies old fallow land now converted to cultivated land was utilized garlic production.
3. 10 field days were organized by field staff to women farmers to provide technical information i.e. seed and soil treatment to control pest attack etc.
4. It is recorded from the field that 7 qtls garlic was produced and sale at local market.

**Out come : Farmers earn cash income of Rs. 6000/= to 7000/= Rs. through selling garlic to local villagers .**

#### **Objective :**

1. To ensure nutritional Security of poor women including children.
2. To provide Economic leadership to poor women in the villages.
3. To aware women farmers how to link them with local market.

#### **Progress :**

1. HNBGU Project team distributed the hybrid vegetable seed cabbage and Cauliflower (variety Varun) to 27 house hold at Bangdwara, Paturi, Kathuli, Kangsali and Mandar villages, Pratapnagar and Jakhnidhar block, Srinagar (Garhwal) on December 2016. (Annexure attached – No. 08)
2. High breed Mix vegetables kit (100 Gm every seed - total nos of packets 12 ) in one kit (Lady Finger, Freshbeen, Tori, Lauki, Chilly, Brianjal, Cumber, Radish, Brianjal, Cumber, Loki and Tori) distributed to 75

farmers (Bangdwara, Dharkot, Paturi, Kathuli, Banalee, Kaflog, Khola and Kangsali) in Kissan Ghosthi on 27 May 2017 at Pratapnagar Block, Tehri Garhwal. (Annexure attached – No. 9)

Total 102 women farmers benefited and 10.2 KG Seeds has been distributed.

**Out put-**

- Our staff provides training to 102 women farmer for growing high breed vegetable seed such as line sowing, in Cabbage and Cauliflower vegetable.
- House hold 102 with their 457 family members including children and old age people benefited in 08 villages of Pratapnagar and Jakhnidhar blocks, Tehri Garhwal district.
- It is also recorded that every House Hold earn or some Household save Rs. 1000/- Rs. to 3000/- cash through Vegetable cultivation.

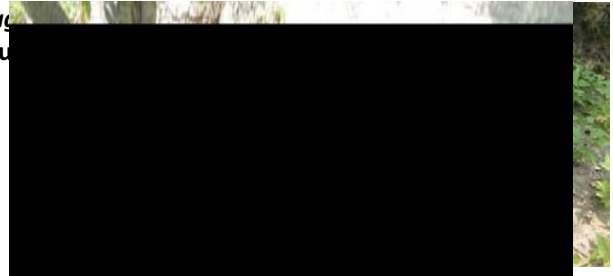

### 1.F.3 Low Cost Poly houses for organic seeds production in Control environment – 02

#### Objective:

***Following issues were discussed during the Kissan Goshties :-***

1. Profitable venture like cultivation of off season vegetables will go a long way in removing the poverty of the poor purchasing power of farmers
2. Door step Agri - services are an urgent need of women farmers to develop economic leadership in the area.
3. All participants now regularly discuss about seed and crop selection and how to improve productivity and how to enhance the livelihood
4. Women farmers need special attention towards income generative activities.
5. Strong Market network for the agriculture produce is required.

**Achievements:**

1. The workshop covered various aspects of agriculture and horticulture schemes run by the centre and state Government departments and how farmers can get benefit from these schemes.
2. Shri K.S. Panwar, BDO Pratapnagar said that most of the government schemes are primarily focusing on the increasing income of rural marginalized poor. There is an urgent need to look impact of climate and weather in agriculture and other allied sector so as to arrive at a better understanding of what kind of climate resilient technologies would be better on long run Block Officers also address farmers gathering and said that SEWA-THDC & HNBGU is continuously working on building the capacity of small and marginal farmers of this area ensuring that women poor farmers should able to get their right on Govt. schemes especially in agriculture, horticulture and animal husbandry schemes.
3. After a long discussion among the women farmers and Govt. Officers, experts, it was mutually agreed that the Govt. officers will periodically visit to the Pratapnagar and Jakhnidhar blocks areas developed by SEWA-THDC & HNBGU and provide all support and services to them.

### **Output :**

1. Total 125 small and marginal farmers (Total 02 Kissan Goshties) of project area have get lots of knowledge related to agriculture and horticulture schemes. Majority of Schedule cast and other backward class was families and most needy farmers of the area reflects different problems they are facing in agriculture. They also raise the issue of soil dryness, low productivity and pest attack in pulses like Tor, Rajam and Gahath and in vegetables they grow. Due to low productivity of vegetables, pulses and grains, farmers in general and women farmers in particular are not taking healthy diet and pulses, vegetables and fruits are occasionally used by them because of low productivity and low income group. Even some of the poor farmers have never consumed fruits and vegetables. The idea of farmers support centre was also floated under which seed bank and other agricultural inputs and CRA practices will be provided to the farmers. Now It was also envisaged that this activity once initiated would make the farmers self reliant besides improving sustainable agriculture.
2. High breed Mix vegetables kit (Lady Finger, Freshbeen, Tori, Lauki, Chilly, Brianjal and Cumber) distributed to 75 farmers (Bangdwara, Dharkot, Paturi, Kathuli, Banalee, Kaflog, Khola and Kangsali) in Kissan Ghoshti on 27 May 2017 at Pratapnagar Block, Tehri Garhwal.
3. Local villagers also find possibility to get benefit from Govt. Schemes and they approached to Block office and Gram Pradhan to address their needs and demands.


